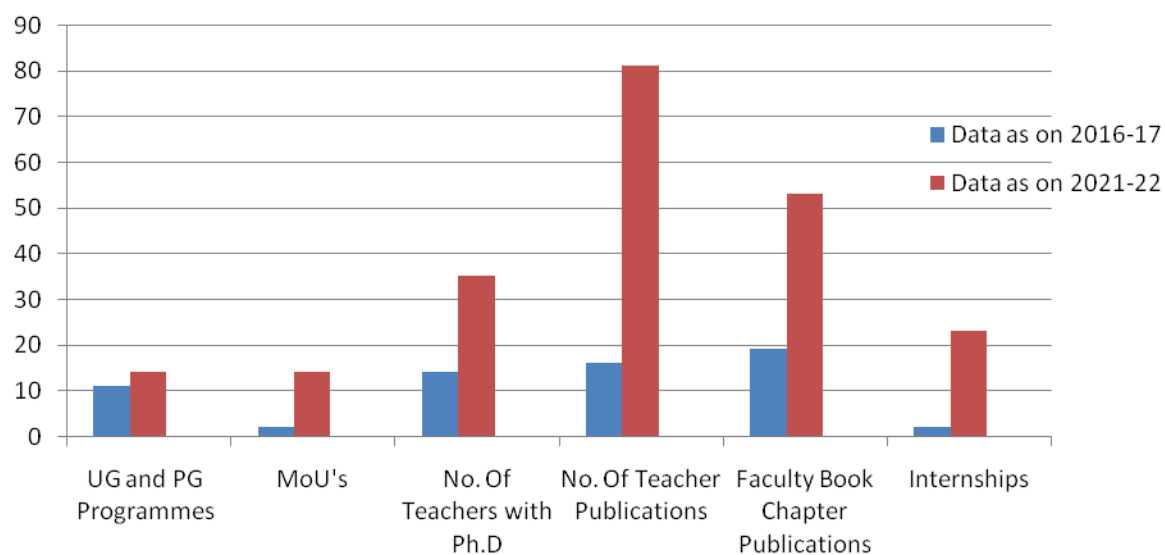

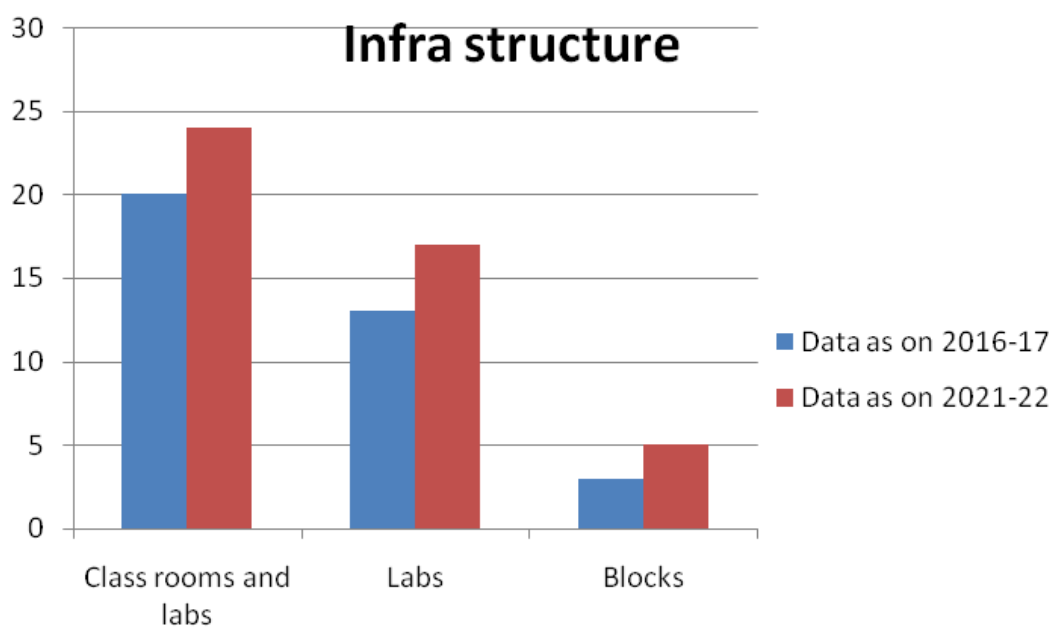
The bar graphs below indicate the growth of the institution and incremental improvements in various aspects.

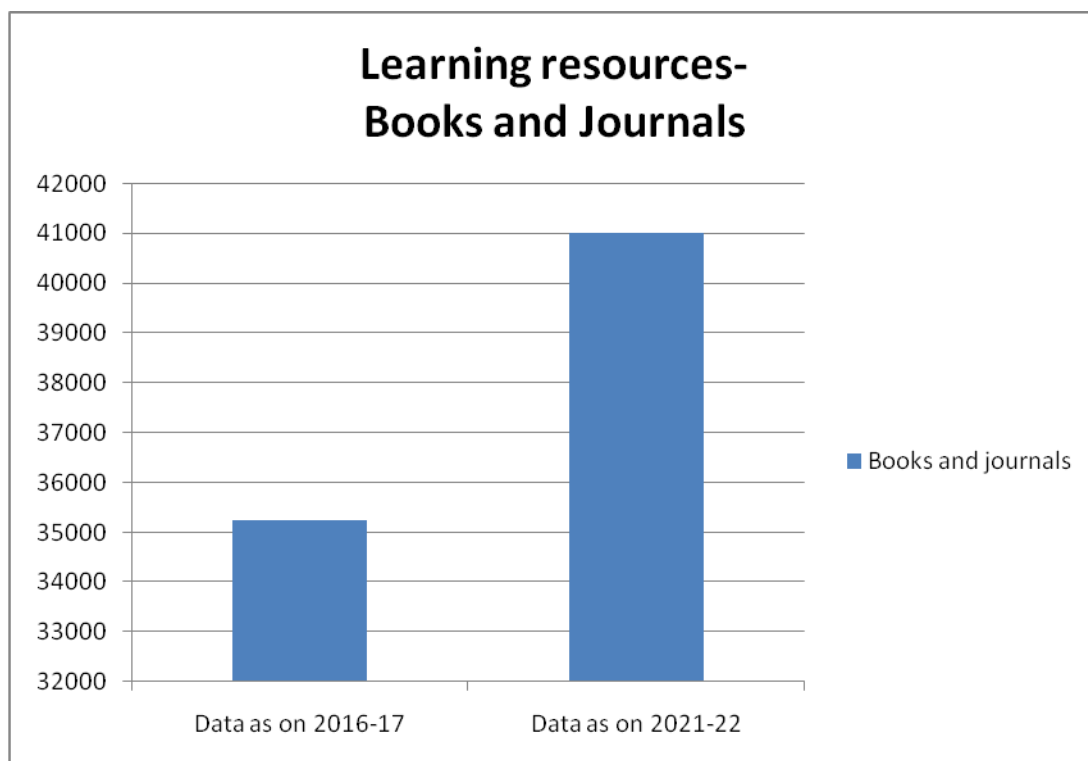


Incremental Growth of the Institution

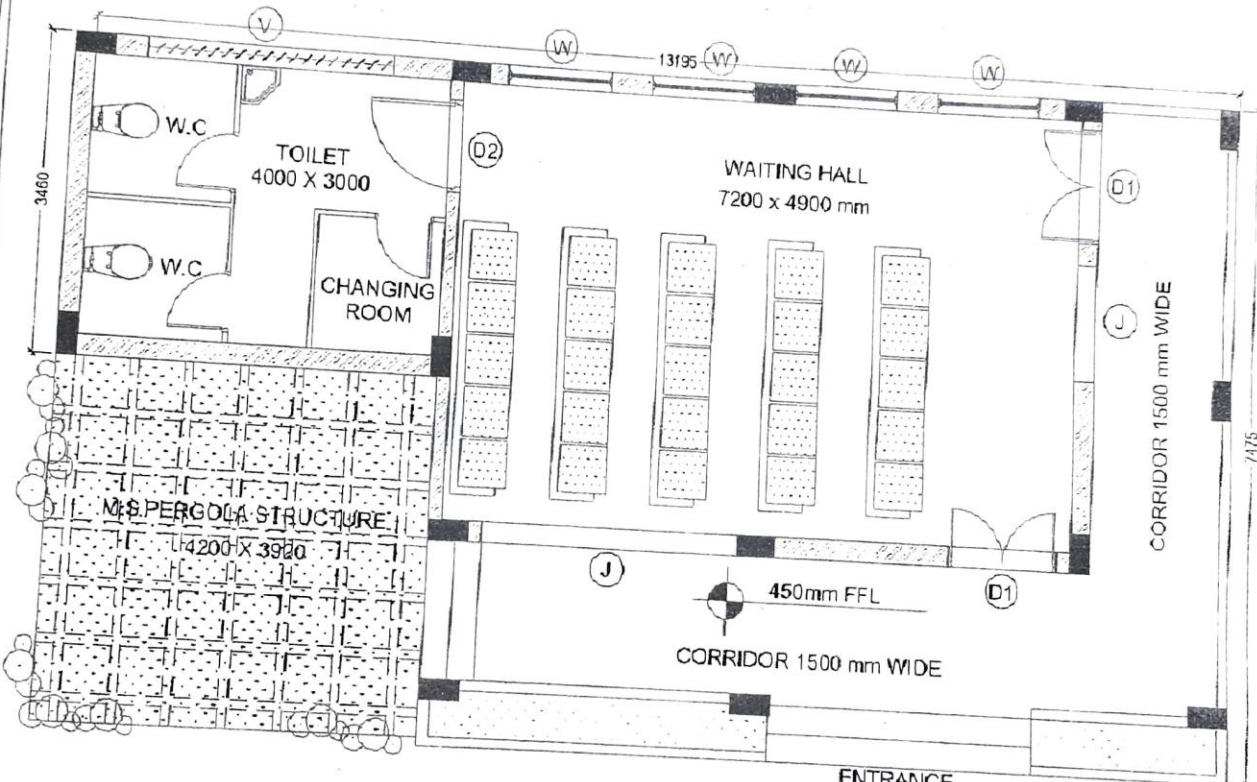

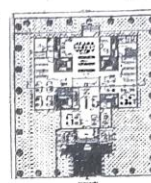
