**Report on feedback by alumni on curriculum, infrastructure and governance, 2022-23**

As a measure of quality enhancement initiative, IQAC of the college makes it a practice to receive feedback from various stakeholders such as students, alumni, academic administrative superiors and teachers. IQAC has planned to take feedback from Alumni on curriculum, infrastructure and governance in order to augment the pace of reform and development towards better activity leading to qualitative enhancement of all the aspects. The feedback is collected from the recent passed out batch as well as from the old alumni. The feedback is taken on the following parameters. These parameters are taken on a five point scale where they have to mark as very good, good, satisfactory, average and poor.

The following analysis can be deduced from the alumni feedback:

Most of the Alumni (54%) rated 'very good' and (41%) of them rated 'good' for Admission Procedure.

The Alumni gave feedback on Fee Structure. 36% of them gave the rating as 'very good' and 39% have given as 'good'.

With regard to the faculty interactions, the alumni have given their feedback. 52% of them have given as 'very good' and 40% of the alumni have rated 'good'.

Regarding knowledge and ability of the faculty, 57% of the alumni have rated as 'very good' and 36% have rated as 'good'.

With reference to relevance of the course to academic and employability progression, 47% of the alumni have rated as 'very good' and 40% have rated as 'good'.

Towards laboratories and equipment, 37% of the students have rated as 'very good' and 43% have rated as 'good'.

35% of the alumni have rated 'very good' and 49% of them have rated 'good' towards the quality of support material.

The parameter, Relevance of the course to profession or social role received feedback with 43% of them rating as 'very good' and 43% as 'good'.

With regard to additional skills acquired apart from regular degree, the students have given feedback with 44% rating 'very good' and 46% rating 'good'.

Projects/Seminars/Guest Lectures received feedback. 60% of the students rated 'very good' and 37% rated as 'good'.

The students have given feedback towards Physical facilities, Library/ Seminar hall / reading room/ computer facilities/ Auditorium/ Play grounds.50% of the students have given 'very good' and 38% have rated 'good'.

Towards Counselling and placements, 31% of the students have rated 'very good' and 38% as 'good'.

For Ambience /environment, 44% of the students have rated 'very good' and the same percentage of students have rated 'good'.

With reference to Activities organized by the college for the overall development, 46% of the students have rated 'very good' and 45% as 'good'.

The students have given feedback towards Sports and cultural facilities and activities, 50% of the students have rated 'very good' and 43% as 'good'.

Towards Extra-curricular activities, 44% of the students have rated 'very good' and 47% as 'good'.

Regarding NCC/NSS/RRC/ YRC, 60% of the students have rated 'very good' and 39% as 'good'.

With reference to Hostel facilities, 20% of the students have rated 'very good' and 45% as 'good'.

Towards Addressing of grievances, 31% of the students have rated 'very good' and 46% as 'good'.

The students have given feedback towards latest technology and emerging trends being embedded in the curriculum, 34% of the students have rated 'very good' and 49% as 'good'.

All the students have given the rating 'good' and 'very good' barring very few(negligibly small) have rated 'satisfactory'

The IQAC is very happy to announce that the college is taking alumni as one of the members in BOS to improve the curriculum.

As part of all this, the college is arranging a registered body for Alumni Committee.

Suggestions:

The following suggestions can be deduced from the analysis of alumni feedback.

- Add employability and market oriented courses in curriculum.
- Need to improve Hostel facilities.
- Need to improve Toilet and Water facilities.
- Modify the Internal Question Paper pattern to multiple choice questions and short answers.
