In this year 2022-23 two of the students got placements in different companies.

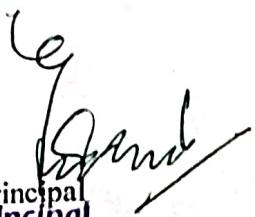
- One of the student got employability in Lakshmi ford, Chemudugunta village, Venkatachalam mandal, Nellore district.
